This Event is a ClubSport Advanced Gravel Sprint promoted by the Dannevirke Car Club (Inc) and will take place on Saturday, 19th may 2018 on Coonor road, Waitahora, Dannevirke.

The Meeting will be held under the current MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its Appendices and Schedules particularly the ClubSport Standing Regulations, Appendix Five, Schedule C.

3. THE EVENT

Venue The event will be held on Coonor Road and continue through onto Towai Road, Waitahora, dannevirke with documentation and scrutineering at the event caravan at the finish line. Coonor Road is at the end of Waitahora road just out od Dannevirke, and is 100% gravel.

Length the event is 4.2 kms long. The road is in excellent condition. And has been used many times as an old Wairarapa /day breaker rally stage

Official and Observations Runs there will be one observation run,a practice and 3 official timed runs . The number of runs being dependent upon the total number of entries received, and force majeure on the day.

Service Park is located at the top of the road next to the finish line in the Browns lime Quarry.

The **HQ caravan** will be situated in the main lime quarry shed.

ENTRIES

Entries open with the publication of these Regulations and close on Tuesday 15th may 2018. Entries postmarked or emailed after the normal closing date will be subject to late entry fee.

Entry Acceptance shall be made on the Official Entry Form attached, and to be deemed valid, must be complete in all details and accompanied by the appropriate entry fee. Acceptance will be at the Organising Committees discretion.

Entry Fee will be \$120.00 per entry. **Late Entry Fee** will be \$150.00

Dual Entries will be accepted, but it is the responsibility of the competitor to ensure that they are ready to start in the correct starting order to be advised, or the run will be forfeited.

Number of Starters will be up to 50.

(a) The organisers reserve the right to abandon the event if less than 20 entries are received by the normal closing date.

CLASSES As this is also round 5 of The Engine Room Sprint Series 2018 classes have been adopted. Full class eligibility can be found at <https://www.dannevirkecarclub.co.nz/files/SERIES-REGS-2018.pdf>

- Class A 2WD 0-1400cc
- Class B 2WD 1400-1750cc
- Class C 2WD 1751cc and over
- Class D 4WD – manufactured after Jan.1st 1996 and all 4WD not eligible for Class E
- Class E 4WD – Pre 1996

Best Run the best time from any of the runs count for the Class and Overall placings.

DOCUMENTATION AND SCRUTINEERING AUDIT

Competitors must present themselves at documentation for the checking of licences and documents, issuing of competitor numbers and applicable advertising material before presenting the car for audit scrutineering. Cars will not be cleared until numbers and advertising are firmly affixed in the appropriate places on the vehicle.

The venue for this is at the event headquarters between 7.45-9.00am

DRIVERS BRIEFING A verbal briefing will be given at the Start Line of the venue at 9.30am. A roll call will be held, all drivers are required to attend.

OBSERVATION RUN CONVOY ONLY. The observation run will commence immediately after the Driver Briefing. This run will be in CONVOY ONLY.

TIMING Cars will start at one minute intervals. The clocks used will be accurate to 0.1 seconds (1/10ths).

ACCIDENT DAMAGE If you do cause damage to fences or other property you must advise an Official at the HQ caravan situated adjacent to the Start Line. You will be charged for cost of repairs at the cost charged to the Club.

RUN NOTES AND RECONNAISSANCE Run notes will not be supplied. You may create notes during the observation run only. You may not hold up the convoy to do these notes.

CAR NUMBERS The car numbers issued to you are the property of the Dannevirke Car Club. You are required to return them to the HQ caravan **BEFORE** you leave the venue. If they are not returned you will be sent an account for \$25.00 per number for their replacement. Please ensure you have tape to affix them to the **front doors** of your car.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Accommodation – there is a variety of motels, hotels and camp grounds available in dannevirke. If required Dannevirke Car Club members may be able to billet some competitors.

Prize Giving will be held at the car club rooms after the event. There are prizes to be awarded. If you are not there, sorry you do not receive your prizes.

Goon Memorial trophy the goon memorial trophy will be up for grabs as millstream road will not be running in 2018.
