Motorsport NZ Clothing Requirements Change on 1 April 2018

This is written to try and figure out the confusing clothing requirement tables in the current Motorsport Manual. It outlines the MINIMUM clothing requirements for Motorsport NZ. - Clubsport Basic Autocross
 - Full covering overalls. Must have a manufacturers label stating 100% cotton
 - Any (All) clothing worn under overalls must be either labelled 100% cotton or wool or labelled with SFI 3.3, ISO 6940, or FIA8856-2000
 - Socks Covering to mid calf. 100% wool or labeled 100% cotton, OR labelled SFI 3.3, ISO 6940, or FIA8856-2000.
 - Leather shoes, OR labelled SFI 3.3, ISO 6940, or FIA8856-2000
- Clubsport Advanced Hillclimbs/Sprints. Same as above, but with better overalls
 - Overalls either:
 - Single Layer Fire Resistant Material (Labeled with either: Nomex, CarbonX, Proban, ProTek, Pyrovatex, Aramid)
 - SFI 3.2a/1 or SFI 3.2a/3
 - ISO 6940 Single layer
 - Underwear required if using single layer overalls
 - Full covering from ankles to wrist to neck. Must be either labelled 100% cotton or wool or labelled with SFI 3.3, ISO 6940, or FIA8856-2000

Rallysprints

- Overalls Same as for Clubsport Advanced
- Must wear close fitting underwear that is either labelled 100% cotton or wool or labelled with SFI 3.3, ISO 6940, or FIA8856-2000. Cotton or wool must be full covering underwear from ankles to wrist to neck. SFI or FIA labeled are available as long or short styles.
- Socks Covering to mid calf. 100% wool or labeled 100% cotton, OR labelled SFI 3.3, ISO 6940, or FIA8856-2000.
- Leather shoes, OR labelled SFI 3.3, ISO 6940, or FIA8856-2000
- Gloves Labelled SFI 3.3, ISO 6940, or FIA8856-2000. Optional for co-driver.
- Balaclava Labelled SFI 3.3, ISO 6940, or FIA8856-2000
