

# SPEEDY RD GRAVEL RALLYSPRINT

## Sunday 22 May 2022



### 1. JURISDICTION

This Event is a ClubSport Advanced Rally Sprint promoted by the Dannevirke Car Club (Inc) and will take place on Sunday, 22 May 2022 on Speedy Road, Dannevirke.

The Meeting will be held under the current MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its Appendices and Schedules particularly the ClubSport Standing Regulations, Appendix Five, Schedule C.

### 3. THE EVENT

**3.1 Venue** The event will be held on Speedy Road, Dannevirke with documentation and scrutineering at the event caravan near the start line. Speedy Road is off Weber Road, approx 27km east of Dannevirke, and is 100% gravel.

**3.2 Length** The event is 6.5 kms long.

**3.3 Official and Observations Runs** there will be one observation run, and up to three timed runs. There may be unofficial runs if time and road conditions permit. The number of runs being dependent upon the total number of entries received, and force majeure on the day.

**3.4 Return to Start Line** There is an 11km open public road return loop for suitable vehicles. All other vehicles will be held at the finish control until cleared to return to the pit area.

**3.5 Service Park** is in the paddock just prior to the start line.

**3.6 The HQ caravan** will be situated on Speedy Road just prior to the Start Line.

### 4. ENTRIES

**4.1 Entries** open with the publication of these Regulations and close on Thursday 19th May 2022. Entries should be made online on the Motorsport NZ Possum system. Entries received after the normal closing date will be subject to late entry fee.

**4.2 Entry Acceptance.** To be deemed valid, must be complete in all details and accompanied by the appropriate entry fee. Acceptance will be at the Organising Committees discretion.

**4.2a** Priority of entry will be given to registered Central Region Sprint Series competitors in case of over subscription. Those not registered in the series that have entered over the 45 car limit will be placed on a waiting list and will be notified on the 20th of May their outcome.

**4.3 Entry Fee** will be \$180.00 per entry. **Late Entry Fee** will be \$200.00

**4.4 Dual Entries** will be accepted, but it is the responsibility of the competitor to ensure that they are ready to start in the correct starting order to be advised, or the run will be forfeited.

**4.5 Number of Starters** will be up to 45.

(a) The organisers reserve the right to abandon the event if less than 20 entries are received by the normal closing date.

**5. CLASSES** As this is also a round of The Central Region Sprint Series 2022 classes have been adopted. Full class eligibility can be found at <https://crss.co.nz/rules/>

- Class A 2WD 0-1400cc
- Class B 2WD 0-1750cc
- Class C 2WD 1751cc and over
- Class D 4WD – manufactured after Jan.1st 1996 and all 4WD not eligible for Class E
- Class E 4WD – Pre 1996

**5.1 Best Run** the best time from any of the official runs count for the Class and Overall placings.

**6. DOCUMENTATION AND SCRUTINEERING AUDIT** Will be held on the day from 8.00am to 9.30am. Competitors must present themselves at documentation for the checking of documents, issuing of competitor numbers and applicable advertising material before presenting the car for audit scrutineering if the car hasnt been remotely scrutineered. Cars will not be cleared until numbers and advertising are firmly affixed in the appropriate places on the vehicle.

**6a. This Event will be run using Remote scrutineering system**

Competitors are to arrange with one of the scrutineers on the list below to perform a scrutineering audit within the 8 days prior to the event. Audits may be carried out from the 14th May 2022 and inspections carried out no later than the 19th June 2021. Other scrutineers may be added at the discretion of the Chief Scrutineer. If you wish to use a scrutineer not listed below contact the Chief Scrutineer. Scrutineering is available on the day but at a limited capacity.

**7. DRIVERS BRIEFING** A verbal briefing will be given at the Start Line of the venue at 9.30am. A roll call will be held, all drivers are required to attend.

**8. OBSERVATION RUN** The observation run will commence immediately after the Driver Briefing. This run will be in **CONVOY ONLY**.

**9. TIMING** Cars will start at one minute intervals. The clocks used will be accurate to 0.1 seconds (1/10ths).

**10. ACCIDENT DAMAGE** If you do cause damage to fences or other property you must advise an Official at the HQ caravan situated adjacent to the Start Line. You will be charged for cost of repairs at the cost charged to the Club.

**11. RUN NOTES AND RECONNAISSANCE** Run notes will not be supplied. You may create notes during the observation run only. You may not hold up the convoy to do these notes.

**12. CAR NUMBERS** The car numbers issued to you are the property of the Dannevirke Car Club. You are required to return them to the HQ caravan **BEFORE** you leave the venue. If they are not returned you will be sent an account for \$25.00 per number for their replacement. Please ensure you have tape to affix them to the **front doors** of your car.

**13. GENERAL INFORMATION**

**Accommodation** – there is a variety of motels, hotels and camp grounds available in Dannevirke. If asked, Dannevirke Car Club members may be able to billet some competitors.

**Prize Giving** will be held in the service area after the event.
